You may be eligible to secure Federal Flood Mitigation funding to pay 75% of the construction cost of improvements to reduce flooding damages to your house. A grant under the Federal Emergency Management Pre-Disaster Mitigation Program (PDM) can be used to:

■ Home Improvement- Structure Raising

- Elevating the structure to 2 ft above 100 yr flood elevation,
- Utilities relocation,
- Concrete foundation enhancement, and
- Fill-around structure and in basement/crawl space.

■ Basement Improvement

- Fill in Basement/Crawl space,
- Relocate HVAC ducts aboveground,
- Back flow preventers on sanitary pipe, and
- Relocate utilities to first floor.
